Minutes of the Annual Parochial Church Council Meeting

7. Presentation of the Accounts

Jill Thomas reported that the accounts for 2022 for St. Leonard's had been audited. At the end of 2022 we have a little over £9,000 in hand.

An insurance claim has been made to cover the cost of the damage to the cemetery wall caused by a car. The second time this has happened in a relatively short period of time.

People have continued their Standing Order payments and there have been additional generous donations.

Jill was thanked for her good work in keeping the accounts. Please see the Statement of Accounts for a full breakdown. These are published annually.

St. Michael's have had their accounts audited, have paid their contribution to the quota in full and continue to fund-raise with Quiz Nights, Cream Teas, and the Plant Sales to keep up with the cost of the church's upkeep.

Angela Dyer was thanked for keeping the accounts for St. Michael's.

8. Appointment of Auditors.

Jill Thomas proposed Martin Broadley for St Leonard's and David Thompson was proposed for St. Michael's. These were agreed unanimously.

9. Vicar's Remarks

Noel showed slides to illustrate his talk. "Rejoice in hope" was his opening statement that serves as a good reminder for us. He thanked the many people who are involved in innumerable ways in supporting the life of the church in worship and in fellowship. He urged everyone to "make hospitality your special care". And quoted "Be the change you want to see".

He urged us to begin with ourselves, to bring our best selves when we come to church. We should aim to be continually transforming our minds; not just for one day each week.

The Living God's Love theme continues, and its mission tells us that every encounter has meaning and purpose. We should think of ways in which we can integrate new people in our churches from the new estates in the area.

Noel closed by showing a slide of the washing of feet to remind us of our duty of service.
